The Newsletter Judging Criteria does more than establish standards for judging. It makes an outline of what an editor should utilize to publish a newsletter that is both interesting and informative, that encourages readers to enjoy the publication and that conveys a sense of pride in the Detachment.

Newsletters can serve as a valuable tool to communicate with all members of a Detachment. It is the most convenient way of keeping in touch with members, Marines and other Detachments. Newsletters can also be an effective recruiting or public relations tool. It should serve as a means by which the League can reach out to its Member, the general public and potential members as well as for the officers of the Detachment to make their members aware of goals and achievements of the Detachment and encourage participation.
